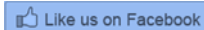

ADMINISTRATIVE COUNCIL 2ND QUARTER MEETING

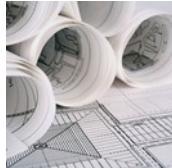
SUNDAY, JUNE 10, 2018
